The seven witnesses brought a wealth of knowledge and evidence to the Commissioners, including the need to make significant changes to the existing family and child welfare system, with adequate supports and funding to ensure families flourish rather than fear their children will be apprehended.

The final Knowledge Keeper, Expert and Institutional Hearing will be held in St. John’s, Newfoundland and Labrador from October 15 to 18, 2018. The topic of discussion will be Sexual Exploitation – human trafficking and sexual violence.
