We are ensuring that the National Inquiry's work is not disrupted during this time of transition. Director of Operations Calvin Wong will act as Interim Executive Director effective immediately.

We will continue to build on the significant progress achieved last year in the Truth Gathering process that has shed light on this national tragedy through:

- community hearings;
- expert panel hearings;
- institutional hearings;
- commemoration; and,
- research.

We have a sacred responsibility to the 597 families and survivors who have entrusted the National Inquiry with their truths and the 600 more who are registered to do so.

Commissioners and staff are united by a deep commitment, and we are working diligently to prepare for our next two community hearings in Yellowknife on January 23-25, 2018, and Rankin Inlet on February 20-22, 2018.
