To all families and survivors in Manitoba:

The National Inquiry will have a team made up of staff from the Health, Community Relations, and Legal teams on the ground in southern Manitoba the week of July 24, 2017. The teams will be reaching out to those of you near Winnipeg and Sagkeeng who intend on participating in the National Inquiry.

These community visits will help us all to plan and prepare for Community Hearings that are part of the overall Truth Gathering Process that will take place in Winnipeg the week of October 16, 2017.
