The community visit is an opportunity for families and survivors of violence to register to participate in the Inquiry and prepare for the community hearing to be held in Mani-Utenam, Week of 27 November 2017.

Health workers will be present to support you. Share your story, start your healing, educate the population, recommend changes, pay tribute to your loved one.
