Community Hearings of the Truth Gathering Process

Happy Valley-Goose Bay, NL – March 7-8, 2018

Commissioner Qajaq Robinson will be in Happy Valley-Goose Bay, Newfoundland and Labrador for a Community Hearing from March 7 – 8, 2018. The daily hearings are expected to begin at 8:00 AM AST and are scheduled to end at 5:00 PM AST each day. There are a variety of ways to provide testimony throughout the week - public and private hearings, artistic expression and through statement gatherers.

The Commissioners' mandate is to examine and report on the systemic causes of all forms of violence against Indigenous women, girls and LGBTQ2S people in Canada by looking at patterns and underlying factors.
