Elisapi Aningmiuq focuses on communications and life-style that promote the culture, talent and values of the Inuit. She works on healing and wellness initiatives, and on finding wellness through life skills education and self-development. Elisapi has a long history of involvement with community-based social advocacy and wellness programs in Iqaluit. For this involvement, she was awarded the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal also the Polar Medal.

Elisapi has developed a wide range of knowledge and expertise on the community's social, well being and mental health issues. She continues to be highly involved with the operation of the Iqaluit Community Tukisigiavik Centre.

With her journalistic background Elisapi has extensive experience as a radio broadcasting with CBC and was Executive Producer with Inuit Broadcasting Corporation for several years.

As a graduate from Fur Production and Design Program at Nunavut Arctic College, Elisapi is also producing many more Inuit designed garments and accessories.

Elisapi was born in a camp south of Kimmirut, Nu. Moved to Iqaluit as a young girl and has seen Iqaluit grow from couple of hundred people to what is now the capital of Nunavut.
