Mike was the lead Commissioner on the Mushkegowuk People's Inquiry on Suicide in 2015 – 2016. He maintains an advocacy role in addressing the opioid addiction crisis in the Mushkegowuk communities.

Concurrent to his involvement with the various boards, Mr. Metatawabin also served as Chief of his community of Fort Albany from 1998 to 2006.

Having served as board member and president/chairman on numerous regional organizations, Mr. Metatawabin has established a solid foundation in maintaining his relationships with various government agencies ranging from the local to National levels.
